- All conditions & restrictions outlined on the front and back of this permit apply to all levels of the permit at all times.
- Activation of a FIRE RESTRICTION (campfires only) or a FIRE BAN will immediately cancel all permits.
- M/B Fire Dept. reserves the right to visit burn sites to confirm compliance.

Any person shall be held liable for costs at MTO rates per truck per hour who:

- Sets out a fire without a permit during the fire season
- Interferes with, refuses to extinguish or to assist in the extinguishment of a fire
- Is responsible for a fire in violation of McNab/Braeside Current Open Air Burning By-Law and the conditions set out on the front and back of this permit

Ontario Forest Fires Prevention Act / Ontario Regulation 207/96 Ontario Fire Protection & Prevention Act / Ontario Regulation 213/07	McNab/Braeside Additional Restrictions
<p>1. No person shall start a fire outdoors unless conditions will allow the fire to burn safely from start to extinguishment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No person who starts a fire outdoors shall leave the fire without leaving a person in charge of the fire.</li> <li>• A person who starts a fire outdoors or, if the person who started the fire is not present, a person in charge of a fire outdoors shall take all necessary steps to tend the fire, keep the fire under control, and extinguish the fire before leaving the site.</li> </ul> <p>2. No person shall start or tend a fire outdoors...during the fire season...unless all of the following conditions are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The person is burning piled wood, brush, leaves or discarded wood by-products.</li> <li>• A responsible person is available to tend the fire until it is extinguished.</li> <li>• The material is burned in a single pile that is less than two metres (7 feet) in diameter and less than two metres (7 feet) high.</li> <li>• The person tending the fire has tools or water adequate to contain the fire within the fire site.</li> </ul> <p>3. No person shall make or tend a fire in an incinerator...unless all of the following conditions are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The person is burning wood, brush, leaves or discarded wood by-products</li> <li>• The incinerator is an enclosed device constructed entirely of non-combustible materials</li> <li>• The incinerator is at least 7.62 metres (25 feet) from any forest area.</li> <li>• The incinerator is at least 7.62 metres (25 feet) from any flammable materials</li> <li>• The outlet of the incinerator is covered with a screen having a mesh size of not more than five millimetres.</li> <li>• A person who starts a fire in an incinerator shall ensure that a responsible person monitors the fire until it is extinguished.</li> </ul> <p>4. No person shall start a fire...for cooking or warmth unless all of the following conditions are met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The site of the fire is bare rock or other non-combustible material</li> <li>• The fire is at least 7.62 metre (25 feet) from any flammable material in all directions</li> <li>• The space above the one metre (3 feet) area around the fire is at least three metres (10 feet) from vegetation</li> <li>• The fire does not exceed one metre (3 feet) in height and one metre (3 feet) in diameter.</li> </ul>	<p>1. All fires must be guarded at all times by a responsible person with adequate manpower, tools and water supply for suppression until the fire is dead out.</p> <p>2. No person shall start or tend a fire outdoors during the Fire Season unless a Permit has been issued and all conditions of said permit are met</p> <p>3. No fires are to be started or allowed to burn during windy conditions (not greater than a light breeze of 6 to 11km/hr felt on face; leaves rustle; ordinary vanes moved by wind).</p> <p>4. Grass fires are prohibited during the fire season.</p> <p>5. All fires must be located at least <u>seven point sixty two (7.62) metres (25 feet)</u> from any flammable material in all directions.</p> <p>6. Fire Restriction (campfires only) and FIRE BAN (no burning of any kind + no fireworks) shall be strictly enforced.</p> <p>7. <b>BEFORE BURNING – verify that there is not a fire ban in effect. (Township website <a href="http://www.mcnabbraeside.com">www.mcnabbraeside.com</a> or 613.316.2097)</b></p>
