4. Updates:

Township Walking Trails (width of opening)

Recreation Director Geoff Patterson advised that the legal standard is 10 feet and the measurement of the distance between blocks at the current barriers in the Township varies greatly. The Committee discussed winter use and the restriction of access to the trails. It was recommended that closer to winter the Township approach the local snowmobile club to assist with access to the trails.

Wheelchair Accessible Picnic Tables

Recreation Director Geoff Patterson advised that one wheelchair accessible picnic table was purchased this year but has not yet been assembled. Mr. Patterson further advised that he has found a local supplier who may be able to build the tables cheaper than the current supplier and that supplier is currently working on prototypes for the Township. This item will be brought forward to the next Accessibility Advisory Committee meeting.

5. New Business:

- Building Update - Ryan Frew

Public Works Director Ryan Frew advised that the RA Centre is anticipated to be completed in mid-October. Mr. Frew further advised that the Perneel Building and Municipal office building are scheduled to be completed in mid-December. It was explained by Mr. Frew that the Perneel Building may be ready earlier but the two buildings have some shared services including power and connected water and septic services which would result in both buildings being habitable at the same time.
