# 8.0 BRAESIDE RA CENTRE

8.1 Review of Progress – Greenview Site Report

Mr. Frew reviewed the report provided by Greenview Environmental as to the current status of the progress of the construction of the recreation building in Braeside. Mr. Frew

advised that a trailer has been set up as a change room for the skaters and temporary lighting has also been arranged by the Recreation Director for the outdoor rink.

The Building Committee discussed the possibility of having a conduit installed for the future installation of security devices, however, decided that at this time it should not be added to the project in an attempt to save costs.

# 9.1 Review of Progress - +VG Site Report

Mr. Frew provided a review of the report that was submitted by +VG Architects that summarizes what has been done to date at the Perneel Building. Mr. Frew advised that there was mould found in the insulation, this insulation will have to be removed using abatement procedures. The next major step is to commence the underpinning.

# 9.2 Budget Discussion

Mr. Frew provided an update on the budget. The Building Committee discussed the contingency amounts for the Perneel Building and the Municipal Office and agreed on including a 10% contingency for the Perneel Building and a 5% contingency for the Municipal Office in the budget for these projects. The following recommendation will be brought forward to the January 23, 2018 Regular Council Meeting for consideration of passing: **THAT** Council approve the following overall building project budgets as follows:

- Perneel Renovation and New Municipal Office \$6,545,715
- New Braeside RA Centre \$2,220,000
