## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DEPOT

The Household Hazardous Waste Depot is located at the Renfrew Landfill Site - 376 Bruce Street. This depot will be open from May 6 - August 26, 2017 on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. and Thursdays from 8:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m. This depot is FREE for residents of McNab/Braeside with identification. Acceptable Household Hazardous Waste material is as follows: all types of paint and stains, varnish, turpentine, disinfectants, household cleaners, furniture stripper, ammonia, herbicides, pesticides and insecticides, pool cleaners, propane tanks, oil and brake fluid, oil filters, gasoline, anti-freeze, small home batteries, car and boat batteries.
