2017 FINAL TAX PAYMENT NOTICE

2017 Final Tax Bills have been mailed to Residential and Farm Properties. **Final installments of 2017 property taxes are due on JULY 31, 2017 and SEPTEMBER 29, 2017.** This final tax bill contains payment information for both installments. Additional property tax bills are not mailed out to residents for the 2nd installment. Payments by any method must reach our office by the due date. A penalty of 1¼% per month will be added to any outstanding taxes on the 1st day of each month until paid.
