Over the past 5 years, the Township's residential tax rate has ranked as per the summary below. Appreciable OPP cost increases have played a significant role in the Township's tax requirements over this time period. OPP policing and their implementation of a new billing model across Ontario has increased the Township's tax levy by 13.5% over the past several years. In 2014, the Township was paying \$397,568/year for OPP services. This has increased to an expected \$948,893 in 2018. Long-term asset management planning and associated infrastructure investments, particularly in roads and buildings, have also played a role.
