Sandbags - Please keep bags intact and in place until the water recedes enough to move them. A Request for Quote for Sandbag retrieval has been sent out to be completed by June 30, 2019. If you would like to remove the sandbags yourself, please take them to the landfill site.

Flood Debris, Flood Damaged Building Material and Furniture – A Landfill voucher can be picked up at the Township Office during regular hours for property owners in the flood zone (photo I.D. must be presented). Any flood debris (washed-up or clean-up), flood damaged building material or flood damaged furniture can be taken to the McNab/Braeside Landfill free of charge with the use of this voucher. The voucher can be used until July 13, 2019. The landfill is located at 573 Calabogie Road. Please separate your metal and debris from other material. Household garbage is to be disposed of in the regular fashion. Hazardous waste is not accepted at the landfill.
