The Township's Municipal Emergency Control Group met at noon today, March 17, 2020, to review the current COVID-19 situation. As you know, the Province has been taking significant steps to limit the transmission of the COVID-19 virus. As a result, McNab/Braeside Township has implemented the following measures, effective immediately:

- In addition to our Recreation Buildings, please be advised that public access to the Administration Building, Public Works Building, Landfill and the Fire Stations have been suspended to the public, due to COVID-19 precautions.
- All departments are open for business. Please contact staff by phone and/or email.
- Regular garbage and blue bin pick up will still occur, unless further notified.
- Residents are encouraged to make property tax payments online or utilize the afterhours drop box at the office.
- Our Management Team continues to monitor the situation and take direction from the Federal and Provincial governments and Health Unit. As the situation continues to evolve, we will continue to keep you updated. Communication will be posted on the main page of the Township website and Township social media platforms.
- As always, staff and residents are encouraged to be proactive and follow Health Unit directives on protecting themselves and their family during this situation.
