Termination of State of Emergency

July 8, 2019

Mayor Peckett has terminated the state of local emergency under the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, which was declared on April 26, 2019. Termination of the emergency does not impact recovery efforts or provincial funding programs.

Flood debris continues to be accepted at no charge at the landfill at 573 Calabogie Road, Arnprior, during regular hours of operation (Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.). Landfill Vouchers can be obtained at the Township Office. Vouchers will be accepted at the landfill until July 31, 2019.

The company “Marshall’s” has been contracted by the Township and has commenced the pickup of sandbags in flood affected areas, you do not have to register to have your sandbags picked up.

The Ministry of Municipal Affairs & Housing will be conducting sessions to assist those applying to the Disaster Recovery Assistance Program. These sessions will occur on Tuesday, July 23rd at the Eagle’s Nest in Eganville at 3:00 p.m., on Tuesday, July 23rd at 6:30 p.m. at the Westmeath Community Centre, Wednesday, July 24th at the Shady Nook Hall in Laurentian Valley at 3:00 p.m. and on July 24th, at the Community Centre in Horton at 6:30 p.m.). McNab/Braeside residents are welcome to attend any of the above sessions.

The Township would like to thank all volunteers and partners for their collaboration and efforts during this emergency. The Township remains in recovery mode.
