TILE DRAIN/ROAD CROSSING POLICY

- 1. This Policy is intended to cover all Tile Drain/Road Crossings.
- 2. There shall be no tile drain crossing the property of the Township of McNab/Braeside until an adequate outlet has been provided, and an agreement in writing has been obtained from abutting downstream owners who may be affected by water run-off. A copy of said agreement must be presented to the Township by the applicant.
- 3. The applicant must obtain locations and approvals from all utilities (Bell, Hydro, etc) and avoid disturbance of other utilities during placement of the tile drain.
- 4. Where tile drains must cross under Township roads, the crossing material shall be corrugated steel pipe or rigid plastic pipe and shall be placed from fence line to fence line. The distance from the top of the pipe to the lowest ground elevation in the ditch shall not be less than 0.5 meter.
- 5. The method of installation under Township roads shall be determined by the Roads Superintendent. The applicant will be charged an Inspection Fee of \$150.00.
- 6. The applicant shall be responsible for the costs of any installation, i.e. boring, trenching, materials and installation.
- 7. No open excavation will be allowed to remain on any portion of the travelled roadway, including shoulders, after sunset, unless pre-authorized by the Township.
- 8. The applicant or the contractor representing the applicant, shall be responsible for the supply and maintenance of proper signs, barricade and lights at the crossing site, and must ensure that there are sufficient flagmen available to control traffic. The applicant shall also supply and place proper direction signs for detours, if necessary, in accordance with the procedures outlined in the latest edition of Book 7 of the Ontario Traffic Manual.
- 9. The Township must be advised of the date and time of any work to be carried out on Township property by the applicant and all such work must be inspected by the Township and must meet with Township approval.
- 10. The applicant or contractor representing the applicant will be responsible for all clean-up after construction has been completed to the satisfaction of the Township.
- 11. The Township of McNab/Braeside assumes no liability for damage to persons or property during construction or as a result of the crossing.
- 12. The Township of McNab/Braeside assumes no responsibility for the maintenance of the tile drain road crossing.

- 13. If the workmanship is not to the satisfaction of the Township, the Township would restore the Road to its satisfaction with its own forces. The applicant would be billed for the cost of the time and material incurred by the Township.
- 14. No Tile Drain/Road crossing to be installed from November 15th to April 15th, unless preauthorized by the Township.

I have read the terms and conditions contained herein and I hereby agree to comply with them. I also understand that I may not commence any work on Township property until such time as I have completed the application form, paid the inspection fees, and permission in writing has been issued by the Township of McNab/Braeside.
