Goshen Road: The Road construction work has begun and work is ongoing. There has been a delay in receiving the MNR permit for changing one of the road crossing culverts however this has not cause an impact on the overall schedule as of yet.

Young Road: The work on Young Road is to commence this week and continue until completion.

Duncan Drive: The tender is to close on July 12th and a recommendation be brought to

Council.

Scheel Drive Design: The preliminary design work is ongoing.

New Pick-up Truck: The new truck is in at the dealer and the final add on are being completed.

a) Item: Moore Street – Speeding

The CAO/Clerk indicated that she will forward this issue onto the OPP (Colin Slight).

b) Item: Usborne Street and River Road – Resident Concerns

The Public Works Department will be reviewing the signs along Usborne Street to determine if an adjustment to where the existing speed limit signs are located and if changes to the By-Law are required. The Department will also review the need to add warning signs at the boat launch. The Department will also contact the County of Renfrew to determine if any road repairs are to be done along River Road in Braeside in the next couple years. Several places where the sidewalk crosses a side street there is no transition. To install a sloped transition the County curb would have to be removed and replaced.

a) Item: Joint Recycling and Waste Tender

The Director of Public Works advised that Council has approved the issuing of our Recycling and garbage collection tender as part of a group with adjacent municipalities. The preparation of the tender document is still ongoing and is scheduled to go out in August.
