7.1 Budget Presentation - Day 2

The following amendments/notes were made to this evening's presentation:

There was a line item that would remove the Independent Rink Caretaker in the amount of \$6,300, this line needs to remain in the budget.

The Treasurer also noted that the line item for the "Mobi-mats" was just for the mats themselves and did not include the other items needed to be installed nor did that number include installation, storage, staff time or labour fees. Additional costs could be in the range of approximately \$13,000.00 and up.

The "Building Permit & Inspection" line item on page 35 would remove the increase of \$36,265.00 as the request for a part time position has been removed.

Treasurer Coughlin advised Council of the option to cap the percentage put into reserves for vehicles, building and equipment at 3% as this would lower the levy increase.

Councillor Jacob vacated the Council Chambers at 7:42 p.m.

Staff Direction:

Staff was directed to bring the application for the "ICIP - COVID-19 Resilience Infrastructure Stream" grant forward to Council so that the criteria could be reviewed and a discussion on what project to move forward with could be discussed.

Staff was directed to provide detailed information to Council supporting the increase in programming costs estimating \$13,975 as shown on page 14 of the presentation. This information is required prior to the November 18, 2020 Special Meeting.
