PART I TENDER CALL

Sealed Tenders are invited for the execution of the works described herein.

(Hereinafter the Township)

Tenders shall be received until 2:00 p.m. local time, Tuesday June 10, 2025, at the address given above.

Tenders received by this time, date and at the location specified above, shall be opened and read in public as soon as possible after that time. Public reading of a Tender does not imply any decision by the Township on whether a Tender is or is not irregular.

PART II TENDER CONDITIONS

TC-1 Completion and Submission of Tenders

- 1.1 The Tenderer shall complete all documents pertaining to this Contract in ink or in type.
- 1.2 If the Tenderer is a Corporation, an authorized officer of the Corporation shall sign the Form of Tender and shall affix the Corporate Seal.
- 1.3 If the Tenderer is a partnership, a minimum of two partners shall sign the Form of Tender and the signatures shall be witnessed.
- 1.4 If the Tenderer is a sole proprietorship, the sole proprietor shall sign the Form of Tender and the signature shall be witnessed.
- 1.5 The Tenderer shall submit their Tender by the date and time specified in Part I of the Tender.
- 1.6 The Tenderer shall submit to the Township:
 - a. the Tender and
 - b. all Addenda issued by the Township, with respect to this Contract.
- 1.7 The Tenderer shall submit the Tender on the forms provided by the Township and the Tenderer shall seal the forms in a clearly labelled envelope.

TC-2 Tender Deposit

2.1 A Tender Deposit is not required for this Contract.

TC-3 Agreement to Bond

3.1 An Agreement to Bond is not required for this Contract.

TC-4 Addenda

4.1 The Township will post any addenda on the Township's website (www.mcnabbraeside.com) prior to noon, local time, on Thursday June 5th, 2025. The Tenderer shall ensure that all addenda are received and reviewed.

TC-5 <u>Irregular Tenders</u>

5.1 The Township shall be the sole judge of whether or not a Tender is irregular.

TC-6 Unbalanced Tenders

6.1 The Tenderer shall not submit an unbalanced Tender.

- 6.2 The Township shall have the right to:
 - a. deem a Tender to be unbalanced and
 - b. reject a Tender, which it deems to be unbalanced.

TC-7 Collusion

- 7.1 The Tenderer shall not engage in collusion of any sort and in particular, shall:
 - a. ensure that no person or other legal entity, other than the Tenderer, has any interest in the Tenderer's Tender, and
 - b. prepare their Tender without any knowledge of comparison of figures with or arrangement with any other person or firm preparing a Tender for the same work.

TC-8 Right to Accept or Reject Tenders

- 8.1 Notwithstanding any other provision in this Contract, the Township shall have the right to:
 - a. accept any Tender;
 - b. reject any Tender, and
 - c. reject all Tenders.
- 8.2 The Township reserves the right to reject a Tender of any Bidder who does not furnish satisfactory evidence of sufficient capital, plant and experience to successfully execute and complete the work.
- 8.3 Without limiting the generality of Section TC-8.1 the Township shall have the right to:
 - accept an irregular Tender;
 - b. accept a Tender which is not the lowest Tender, and
 - c. reject a Tender even if it is the only Tender received by the Township.
- 8.4 Acceptance of the Tender shall occur at the time the Township awards the Tender and not necessarily at the time the award is communicated to the successful Tenderer.

TC-9 Contract Documents

9.1 The Contractor shall obtain and review all Contract Documents listed in the Form of Tender and all addenda issued by the Township, pertaining to this Contract.

TENDER A-4 TC-10 **Errors, Omissions and Discrepancies in the Contract Documents** 10.1 If the Tenderer finds any errors or omissions in or discrepancies among the Contract Documents, they shall immediately notify the Township at the address specified in Part I of the Tender. 10.2 No oral explanation or interpretation by any person shall modify any of the Contract Documents. **Irrevocability of Offer** TC-11 11.1 The Tenderer shall not revoke its offer until after the expiration of sixty (60) days after the opening of the Tenders by the Township. TC-12 Successful Tenderer - Bonds 12.1 Bonds are not a requirement for this Contract. TC-13 Successful Tenderer - Workplace Safety & Insurance Board Certificate of Clearance 13.1 The successful Tenderer shall provide the Township with a valid Workplace Safety and Insurance Board Certificate of Clearance, to the satisfaction of the Township's Solicitor. TC-14 Successful Tenderer - Execution of Form of Agreement 14.1 Execution of a Form of Agreement is not a requirement of this contract. 14.2 The Township shall issue a letter to the successful Tenderer to indicate acceptance of the contract. TC-15 Successful Tenderer - Insurance 15.1 The Successful Tenderer shall provide the Township with an original Certificate of Insurance, in a format satisfactory to the Township's Solicitor. 15.2 The Contractor shall carry General Liability and Automobile Liability Insurance in the amount of at least TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000).

<u>TC-16</u> <u>Successful Tenderer – Period of Contract</u>

16.1 The Contractor shall schedule their work under this contract to comply with the following requirements:

Commencement of the work at the Glasgow Public Works Yard and Braeside Public Works Yard shall not begin until after September 2, 2025.

Completion of work at the Glasgow Public Works Yard and Braeside Public Works Yard shall be completed by October 17, 2025.

- The Contractor shall complete the work by the time specified in the Tender, unless an extension of time is granted.
- An extension of time may be granted in writing by the Township in the event of the work being delayed beyond the prescribed time for completion. Such extensions shall be set with fixed terms by the Township. An application for an extension of time shall be made in writing by the Contractor to the Township at least fifteen (15) days prior to the above noted date of completion fixed by the Contract.
- 16.4 If the Township of McNab/Braeside grants the Contractor an extension of time, the Contractor shall complete the work by the revised specified time for completion.

TC-17 Successful Tenderer - Liquidated Damages

17.1 If the Contractor is obliged to pay liquidated damages, the liquidated damages shall be in the amount of **Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)** per day.

TC-18 Successful Tenderer - Submission of Documentation

- The successful Tenderer shall submit the documentation required by Sections TC-13, TC-14 and TC-15 within seven (7) working days of the day the Township notifies the successful Tenderer that the documentation should be sent to the Township.
- 18.2 If the successful Tenderer fails to comply with Section TC-18.1, the Township may, in its sole discretion, withdraw its acceptance of the Tender and the Tenderer shall have no recourse whatsoever against the Township.

TC-19 Prices

19.1 Prices quoted shall be the net cost to the Township and shall include all associated costs (i.e. labour, equipment, material, applicable licences and permits) and all other associated costs required to perform the service to the complete satisfaction of the Township.

TENDER A-7 19.2 The cost for stock piling equipment shall be included in the unit price of the associated item. 19.3 It is agreed that the Tender quantities are estimated only and may be increased or decreased by the Township without alteration of the Tender price. However, such increases or decreases shall not exceed twenty (20%) percent. TC-20 **Payment** 20.1 Payment will be made following the completion of the contract. TC-21 Tax Status 21.1 The unit price quoted shall include all applicable taxes and fees except the Harmonized Sales Tax of 13%. 21.2 The Harmonized Sales Tax (HST) shall be extra to the unit prices quoted. **TC-22 Basis of Award** 22.1 It is the Township's intent to award on a total aggregate price as Tendered; however, the Township reserves the right to award on a line item basis, to the lowest responsive bidders, if deemed to be in the best interest of the Township. 22.2 The Township reserves the right to disqualify any Tender that is incomplete or is otherwise not submitted in strict accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Contract. The Township reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Tenders, should it be deemed to be in the best interest of the Township. Should only one (1) Tender be received, the Township reserves the right to reject 22.3 It is anticipated that the Tender will be awarded by Township Council on June 17, 2025. FT-5 Specification & Confirmation

5.1 The screened winter sand shall be delivered and stockpiled in the Township's sand sheds located at:

- 1. Glasgow Public Works Yard: 2508 Russett Drive, Arnprior, Ontario.
- 2. Braeside Public Works Yard: 721 River Road, Braeside Ontario
- 5.2 The Township of McNab/Braeside shall supply the salt to be mixed with the screened winter sand. The Township shall be notified 10 working days prior to commencement of any operations.
- 5.3 The contractor shall provide sufficient resources to the project to maintain a minimum supply of 900 tonnes of screened winter sand per day of operation.
- The supply of screened winter sand is to be coordinated with the mixing of salt at a rate sufficient to maintain a constant feed to the stockpiling equipment.
- 5.5 The Township of McNab/Braeside reserves the right to inspect material and stacking equipment prior to accepting Tender.
- The screened winter sand shall be selected so that it will conform to the gradation requirements as specified in OPSS.MUNI 1004 for Winter Sand.

Notes:

- 1. In addition to LS-602, to be confirmed by visual inspection of the stockpile.
- 2. The minimum size of the test sample shall be 5 kg. Following oven drying, the sample shall be sieved on the 9.5 mm, 6.7 mm, and 4.75 mm sieves. Material passing the 4.75 mm sieve shall be split to an appropriate size according to LS-602 for subsequent washing and fine sieving. The final grading shall be calculated according to LS-602 as the percentage of material passing each sieve based on the total mass of the oven dried sample.

5.7 Item 3 is a provisional item and may not be awarded as part of the contract or be included in determining the lowest tender price. The Township retains the right to include or exclude the provisional item from the contract award. The contract period as detailed in section TC 16.1 does not apply to the provisional item.
