2014-37: Any vehicle parked on any
street or road allowance within the
Township of McNab/Braeside so as to
prohibit or interfere with snow plowing
operations will be towed away at
owner's risk and expense. No person
shall push, blow or place snow on or
across any Township street or road
allowance. The Township of McNab/
Braeside will not be responsible for
damages to mail boxes, newspaper
containers or other appurtenances that
are privately owned and erected on
Township right-of-ways that may be
damaged through winter snow plowing
