

Council Meeting Summary April 2, 2024

Below you will find highlights of the Township of McNab/Braeside's Council meeting(s) Please note that this summary does not constitute the official record of the meeting and approved minutes should be consulted for that purpose.

- Council authorized staff with proceed with entering into an agreement with EnviroWorld to offer a pre-order sale of backyard composters, rain barrels and accessories to McNab/Braeside residents.
- Reports were accepted from By-Law Services and the Planning Department.
- Provincial Day of Action on litter is May 14th, 2024. The Recreation Department will provide details for an event for this day of action.
- The County of Renfrew Transportation Master Plan Presentation was accepted as information.
- The Township declared April 14-20, 2024, as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week in McNab/Braeside.
- The CAO Objectives for 2024 were approved.
- Mayor MacKenzie's Budget survey was tabled as the Mayor was not in attendance to speak to it.
- A by-Law was passed to Appoint Council Brum to the Renfrew Police Services OPP Detachment Board.
- A closed session was added to this evening's meeting Under Section 239(2) (b). Council resolution following the closed was that Council receive a communication from the Mayor indicating his intention to suspend his activities as Mayor of the Township of McNab/Braeside until further notice.
- 1 Planning Application was received by Council for a Minor Variance 3/24 – Council recommended granting the requested variance.
