- 1. Current Rec. status
 - Recreation Centers are filling up quickly with bookings for birthday parties, events, and weddings.
 - All Rental Agreements have been refreshed and reviewed by the Township lawyer. A package has been prepared to include facility rental price, size, capacity, inclusions and exclusions, a link to obtain a Special Occasions Permit and a rental application.

Changes to include:

- One deposit vs. 2: \$40 key rental was removed, this is included in the security deposit
- All fees are due 14 days prior to event date, including the Security Deposit which will be cashed upon receipt and refunded after a clear inspection post event
- o Cancellation policy: deposits are nonrefundable with less than 14 days' notice
- Should bar sales be less than \$200.00 the Licensee is required to cover the costs of the bartenders
- The Township will run the bar, a SOP is only applicable to serving your own wine (such as at a meal). 'Take Home the Rest' does not apply to homemade wine (per AGCO).
- 2. New Topics
 - Our application for the Jubilee Grant was successful. Funds of \$5,000 will be directed to Waba Gardens and signage to acknowledge the Crown's involvement in making land available for McNab/Braeside residents to purchase after the Laird's departure.
