NOTICE OF DECISION
APPLICATION FOR CONSENT
SECTION 53 OF THE PLANNING ACT

DECISION

Consent for the conveyance a residential lot being Part of Lot 16, Concession 9, in the Geographic Township of McNab, in the Township of McNab/Braesode, in the County of Renfrew consisting of:

Frontage:	61 m	(200 ft.)
Depth:	107 m	(351 ft.)
Area:	1.214 ha.	(3 ac.)

IT IS HEREBY DECIDED that consent be granted for the conveyance of a residential lot subject to the following conditions:

1. That a preliminary Plan of Survey be provided. Upon review and acceptance of the preliminary survey, a registered Plan of Survey in conformity with the sketch depicting the severed lands (as attached to the original or amended application) be supplied to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Land Division Committee.

The registered reference plan shall be provided in the Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM) coordinate system, North American Datum 1983 (NAD83), in both a portable document format (PDF) copy and a digital drawing file (CAD/DWG) of the registered plan.

2. That prior to the issuance of the Certificate of Official the applicant enters into a development agreement with the County of Renfrew in accordance with Sections 53(12) and 51(26) of the Planning Act to implement the recommendations of the Noise Impact Study prepared by Integral DX Engineering Ltd. dated March 12, 2026.
3. That prior to the issuance of the Certificate of Official, the applicant shall provide a solicitor's undertaking to register the Development Agreement on title.

Consent shall be Deemed To Be Refused in accordance with Section 53(41) of the Planning Act within two years of Notice of Decision if proof has not been supplied to the satisfaction of the Secretary-Treasurer before that date that the condition has been met. Critical dates relating to the Decision are listed above.

APPEALING THE DECISION OR CONDITIONS

Take notice that an appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal in respect to all or part of this Decision for Consent may be made by filing a notice of appeal with the County of Renfrew either via the Ontario Land Tribunal e-file service (first-time users will need to register for a My Ontario Account) at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service/> by selecting County of Renfrew as the Approval Authority or by mail to the mail address at the bottom of this Notice, no later than 4:00 p.m. on August 17, 2026. The filing of an appeal after 4:00 p.m., in person or electronically, will be deemed to have been received the next business day. The appeal fee of \$400 can be paid online through e-file or by certified cheque/money order to the Minister of Finance, Province of Ontario. If you wish to appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT) or request a fee reduction for an appeal, forms are available from the OLT website at www.olt.gov.on.ca. If the e-file portal is down, you can submit your appeal to bhowarth@countofrenfrew.on.ca. The County of Renfrew agrees to receive appeals via the OLT e-file service.

Only the Applicant, the Minister, a specified person or any public body may appeal Decisions in respect of applications for consent to the Ontario Land Tribunal. A Notice of Appeal, must set out written reasons in support of the appeal.

If within twenty (20) days of the date of completion of giving of Notice (mailing), no Notice of Appeal is submitted, the Decision is final and binding, and the Secretary-Treasurer is required to notify the applicant and to file a copy of the Decision with the Clerk of the Municipality.
