CURBSIDE LEAF AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION

The Fall collection period will run this week and again the week of October 30th, 2022. Please ensure leaf and yard waste is at the curb before 7:30 a.m. on the Monday of the scheduled week. Pickup will be completed throughout the week and may not correspond with your regular garbage schedule.

Approved Leaf and Yard Waste containers and sizing:
Biodegradable paper bags or in bundles that meet the following requirements. Individual containers must not exceed 23kg (50lbs), trimmed branches must not exceed 25mm (1.0 inch) in diameter, bundles must not exceed 1.5m (5 feet) in length and 0.6m (2 feet) in diameter. Leaf and Yard Waste can also be brought to the Township Waste Disposal Site located at 573 Calabogie Road for no additional charge.

WINTER PARKING & SNOW REMOVAL – EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 15

In accordance with Municipal By-Law # 2022-38: Any vehicle parked on any street or road allowance within the Township of McNab/Braeside to prohibit or interfere with snow plowing operations will be towed away at owner's risk and expense.

No person shall push, blow or place snow on or across any Township Street or road allowance.

The Township of McNab/Braeside will not be responsible for damages to mailboxes, newspaper containers or other appurtenances that are privately owned and erected on Township rights-of-way that may be damaged through winter snow plowing operations.

All basketball nets and other personal belongings must be removed from Township roadways immediately.
