- Rinks: Preparations on the Braeside Rink have begun, and it is set to open by the end of the week. The weather has not been favorable to begin work on the White Lake Rink. The asphalt base requires a large amount of packed snow to act as insulation before flooding can begin.

4. New Topics

- Bartering Services for Rental Fee: The Recreation Director would like to recommend a barter agreement, wherein those who can offer a service of value to recreation programming (such as hockey, baking, crafting lessons) could receive a waived future community centre/ice rink rental fee in exchange for payment.
 - * Resolution moved Adam and seconded by Andy. Determined on a caseby-case basis at the discretion of the Director of Recreation/CAO with support of the recreation committee. This item will be added as a policy. Cases will be shared with the committee in advance where feasible, where time does not permit the Recreation Director/CAO may approve or deny the request.
- Two-tier fee system (resident/non-resident) Background: Resident feedback that they are unable to register for programs as they fill quickly with non-

residents. Should there be a different rate for programs/rentals for those who pay municipal taxes and those who don't?

Mark asked for assistance from the committee to research comparable costs for rentals and programs within 100 km. John requested a list of all programs we offer (current and future) with fee as of today. He will work on these comparables.

Mark recommends wording as: Rental \$135 McNab/Braeside residents \$125

Active Transportation Pathways Subcommittee (Andy)

Andy would like to start an Active Transportation Subcommittee – Mark linked this to Renfrew County Tourism. Signage brings people in to the community to explore new business. The County is responsible for putting signs up on the Algonquin trail. Andy recommended that we could advertise 'what's my three words' app on signage; a unique combination of three word identifies precise locations used for emergency rescue.

Resolution to form this subcommittee- Moved by Matt, seconded by John: Chair Andy Kalnins, Matt Arseneau Vice Chair. Mark shared that there are county resources for this and requested that Andy prepare a document including the K&P Trail, McNab/Braeside Rec Trail that Mark can share with the county.

Darryl Carson (resident)

- Parking at WL Carnival requested that signage be placed at Point Rd. last year there were parking issues as cars were parked on both sides of the street.
